

Classic Structures Water Pressure



The Water Pressure is a structure that emits water from several different orifices beginning with the very lowest. The users hold each orifice to get the water pressure to build up to the next orifice until the water emits from the very top of the structure onto the users below.

Material Options:	Fiberglass
